OPENING TO PUBLIC

Issue 07

We open to the public starting July 11th on weekends 8:00am-4:00pm.

This is a reminder to members of the <u>rules on the ranges open to</u> <u>the public</u>.

- All guests (nonfamily) must pay.
- Any family members under 18 years old must show proof they went through DNR Firearms Safety.
- Members and their immediate families shoot for free, but must immediately give up their station if someone from the public is waiting.
- All targets must be "Bullseye" only, be approx. the same size as OGC targets and one target per shooting station.
- Limit of 1 uncased firearm at a time. Example: you have a firearm with a hot barrel. You want to wait until it cools before casing. The firearm must remain on your bench top until cased.
- No prone nor kneeling positions, sitting and standing only.
- RSOs have complete control of the public range/firing line.
- Members must wear their badge so it is visible for identification as an OGC member. No badge; you're considered public. You be subject to public fees and public range use.
- OGC will continue to follow the State's guidelines and members must follow those guidelines while on OGC property. Those guidelines may at some point impact and supersede the social distancing and PPE (Personal Protection Equipment) requirements.: Postings will be updated as guidelines change. Please review these postings.
- Acceptable "<u>social distancing</u>" requirements must be observed and practiced by all members.

Oakdale Gun Club June 10, 2020 Board Meeting

Meeting opened on ZOOM at 7:30 PM There were 12 Board members in attendance. Not present was Tom Etzel and Dan Burkhart.

Herb: United Way Trap Shoot Proposal for Trap shoots by United Way using our range. There would be 60 shooters, shooting 30 in the morning and 30 in the afternoon. Neil questioned if we would be setting a precedence by allowing the shoot. The shoot would be in October when we may be open to the public. If the people come in and pay the trap rate to shoot like the public then we would not be considered as a sponsor for this event. We would not list it as a sponsored event but only public coming in to shoot. Discussion followed with this item. Discussion tabled while more information is gathered.

Tom M joined the meeting due to problems with ZOOM.

Open to Public July 11: We need to place isolation plastic panels at the cash register area. There will be hand sanitizer placed at the ranges. Liability Waivers will be signed at the registration counter before shooting. Signs will be placed on the ranges for social distancing. It will be up to the public shooter to practice social distancing. Tom M will make up the signs for the ranges.

Finance: Bill gave a report on our current financial status. We are at the status we had anticipated at this time. Tom M to talk to Bill later on spending.

Scooter policy: We will allow scooters for handicap people on the range. They can also be allowed to check targets. The person using the scooter must have a Handicap sticker to use scooter on the range. We need to add ramps on the ranges for access by the scooter. Duane will make up addition to policy manual.

RSO: Neil has been working on an online solution for members to sign up for work hours. We will use Sign Up Genius to start. Hopefully this will be ready by the weekend.. Our planned target is to switch over to new web early Fall.

There was a break in the ZOOM meeting and Board had to sign on again to finish the meeting.

Only used 30 minutes but Tom E was not on so no control on meeting time.

Picnic: Majority vote by the Board to have no picnic this year.

Motion to adjourn Meeting adjourned at 8:15 PM after 40 minutes of ZOOM time.

Obituary for Kenneth Neustel

"Age 85 Died on Tuesday, May 19, 2020, in St. Paul, MN. He was born on Sept. 1, 1934, in Duluth, MN, to Clifford S. and Nora C. (Wick) Neustel. Ken was active in the Boy Scouts and earned his Eagle Scout badge in 1952, when he also graduated from Central High School in Duluth. Ken married Mary E. Siemer in 1959. Ken attended the U of M, Duluth, where he was a member of the Beta Phi Kappa fraternity and earned a degree in sociology in 1960. Ken worked for the State of MN Parole and Probation Dept. until he was hired as a social worker by the St. Paul School System where he retired in 1997. He also worked part time at Scott County Mental Health Services for 30 years. Ken honorably served with the U.S. Army 82nd Airborne Division where he was introduced to parachute jumping. His first sport jump was in Rochester in 1962. He was a lifetime member of the U.S. Parachute Assoc. and was a licensed parachute rigger and examiner, jumpmaster and skydiving instructor. He recorded over 5600 jumps and mentored many individuals in a 40-year commitment to the sport. In 1999, Ken and his wife, Mary, joined members of the International Association of Airborne Veterans with whom they parachute jumped in Mongolia, and again in Jordan in 2000, with Prince Hamzah to honor the life of his father, King Hussein. Because of his commitment to safety as a parachute rigger and skydiving instructor, Ken was inducted into the MN Aviation Hall of Fame in 2012. Ken and Mary were avid outdoors people and enjoyed canoeing the Boundary Waters and hiking Isle Royale. One memorable experience was hiking an Austrian mountain trail for a few days. Ken's other interests included his numerous beloved pets, and active memberships in the West St. Paul Rotary Club and the Oakdale Gun Club. Ken is survived by his wife, Mary; brother, Wesley of Duluth; sister, Marian of Plainfield, IN; and numerous nieces and nephews throughout three generations. A memorial service and inurnment will be held at a later date.
