No Oakdale Gun Club Member Meeting

Oakdale Gun Club May 13, 2020 Board Meeting

Meeting opened on ZOOM at 7:30 PM by President Tom Mader assisted by Tom Etzel There were 12 Board members in attendance. Not present was Tom Acheson and Dan Burkhart.

ADA: Herb gave a report on the results of the ADA group that inspected the range. There are some easy Fixes that can be done right away but we are not sure about a work party at the club and when it can be done. Herb indicated some work can be done easily with a screwdriver. There is easy stuff and work to be done by a contractor. Bill is also looking at the expense and our current situation of Covid-19. We will not know how much expense we can handle until the fall depending on revenue generated by being open to the public.

Patrick McNeil: **Security** We have lots of problems with our current poorly installed system. A lot of the cameras do not work and never could work properly due to the type of installation done by Lloyd. What we need is to use is a hard wired system. At least when wire was run to the ranges fiber optic cable was run that we can use to install a proper system. Floyd has been less than easy to work with. He is talking with an attorney to see if we can recoup some of our money paid to Lloyds. He got some quotes for installation of a proper system at about \$30,000. In addition the card system at the gate is so old that it is no longer supported. Could cost about \$9,000 to upgrade. Discussion followed with Bill watching the current situation as relates to the budget.

Motion was made to open the gun club with caveat of social distancing by Patrick . Motion will allow up to 3 guests and no limit to number of family members. Members are responsible for their own disinfecting and maintaining social distance while on the range. Bill brought up the current law of the state that there can only be 10 people or less in the class room. Discussion followed about the Current law. Members will be responsible for maintaining social distancing. All Board present voting aye. to open the club 100 percent. All non-member shooters must fill out the waver form before they can shoot. There was discussion about High School Trap shoots at the club. Board wants to be sure the schools still covers the insurance for the school trap to shoot at OGC.

New members are being scheduled for orientation at the club using a number of 10 people per class.

Calendar: VP will work to update the calendar to be sure the public has current info of the club.

RSO scheduling: Neil working with issues with logons. Met with Tom Etzel and the developer and updated what needs to be done. Have some issues with more than one person on the same Email address. This is especially for wife and husband members. Have some members with identical first, middle initial and last name to be resolved. The new website is addressing these issues.

Bill: Will need to work closely with IT and Building and Grounds to squeeze their budget to get money to update the security. Patrick added we need to get the security updated before we open in July. Bill will focus on spending to dampen it down to allow for Security update.
