OGC October Member Meeting Minutes

OGC Member Meeting October 13, 2021

Meeting opened at 7pm by President Tom Mader.

The pledge was said.

There were 22 members present.

Secretary Report. Duane read the minutes of the last Board meeting September 08, 2021. Minutes were approved as read with no changes.

Annual Meeting: The Annual meeting will be held at Oak Marsh Golf Club on December 18. 2021. This is the same location as previous years. Dean Cody questioned the date of the meeting as being 1 week before Christmas. The Bylaws state the Annual meeting must be held on a Saturday in December.

New Bylaws: There were no new Bylaws, so nothing needs to be done for them.

Ballot counting: The annual meeting requires The President to appoint and election judge who in on the Board of Directors and not standing for re-election or running unopposed. The Election judge shall randomly select from the member volunteers not running for office 4 voting members to carry out the election process. Patrick McNeil will be the election judge and Kirby Oleson, Byron Patterson and Shauna Patterson will be part of the volunteer members.

Member Questions: Bob Ries questioned, "what is the cost of the trap building"? He questioned the approval of the costs by the Executive Committee of both the trap building and the toilets. Also, do we have estimates of the costs of the Bathroom and the Trap building. Daryll indicated the cost of the building minus the floor was \$67,400 to be completed this year.

Next year due to tree removal the soil needs to settle so there will be more costs for a concrete floor and electrical including a card reader. Daryll indicated he asked for bids from several contractors, but several would not bid due to problems in getting materials and prices of materials at that time. Gail A. indicated the cost of the bathroom construction this year is around \$41,500 to include the well inspection, water line installation, tanks installation and tree removal. She said next year they hope to start in March or April to do the actual facility building completion at a cost of \$87,000. Bob was satisfied with the info.

Web Site: Tom E was absent. Gail indicated there had been updates to the website, so work is being done.

Treasure Report: Bill could not be here, so Tom M gave the status. He indicated we are down about 50% on revenue so far this year compared to last year. Adjustment can be made this year if needed per Bill. Bill indicated overall we are OK.

Door Prize: A drawing was held for the Door prize at the end of the meeting with Denis Husnik winning.

Treasure Report: given by Tom M. We are down about 50% from last year. May need to have a restrictive budget over and above the normal expenses in 2022.

Contracts and Bidding Process: Tom M, we did have contracts for our projects this year. No where in the Bylaws does it state we must have three bids, it's just good business practice. Problem this year has also been in getting contractors to bid and the crazy material prices. In the future Tom M wants to be sure we have solid contracts in detail with costs and time and project detail.

Nomination Committee: Discussed the language in the bylaws to select the election committee. Will discuss more later. Will put out Email blast to ask if anyone is running for any of the Director positions. We know Treasure, Security, and Legislative and Trap positions are open. Will have to have a required date for people to submit nominations for directors. Should be submitted by November 15. All members including directors should indicate they are running for office.

Absentee Ballot: Will include Absentee Ballot procedure in the Eblast to members.

Annual Meeting: The door prizes will have a \$750 limit this year due to budgeting.

New Waiver: Patrick has completed the new waiver for new member and renewals. The website has been updated to have the new waiver.

GM: Nothing new to report.

High School: High School will be responsible to supply gate guards when we are not open to the public. This applies only for fall shooting.

Security: Patrick, Cable lines were shot at for a camera on the short range. Will require update of line and camera expense.

Toilets: Gail. Tanks in and water lines in. Done for now will start again in March-April.

In Memory of Ron Kjellman





OGC Member Ronald Kjellman passed away 10-12-2021

Ron Kjellman passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday October 12th, only one day short of the US Navy's birthday, with whom he had proudly served for many years and retired as a Chief Petty Officer. He left behind a loving wife Eileen and family/kids and grand kids, as well as many circles of friends, including those who knew him at the St Paul/Eagan Post Office as well as here at Oakdale Gun Club.

Born on June 23rd. 1959, Ron was a member of OGC for almost twenty years, joining back in 2003 to shoot with many of his buddies whom he worked with at the St. Paul Post Office. He was a staunch supporter of the Second Amendment as well as the right to personal protection, having permits to carry and urging others to support that right as well as other gun legislation. He worked very hard with 'Concealed Carry Reform Now' and other groups to help get the right to carry laws passed here in Minnesota.

He also became interested in passing his knowledge on to others, first getting involved as a Minnesota Firearms Safety Instructor and working with the March Class for several years. He was so good that we talked him into helping teach the "Introduction to Firearms for Women' classes we held every spring and to say Ron was good is a gross understatement....he was superb and one of the best instructors we have ever worked with. As he did training in the Navy, he had a lot of experience and the kids and Ladies hung on every word. He just had "the voice" as well as a great technique and helped us teach for years.

He loved Jimmy Buffets music and was a self-proclaimed "parrot-head" who also had a couple real parrots (who will also miss him). He went down to Kentucky to shoot machineguns with a few of us Postal/Gun club friends in 2010 and we all had a blast! He was as unique a person as I have ever met. He was a regular at the club too, often shooting with his Daughter Elisabeth or his son Ian, and was always a friendly face at the annual meeting with a big smile and such a positive attitude that everyone he talked to left feeling better about their day. He'd literally give you the shirt off his back (or Kilt – he was a proud Scot!) if you said you needed it....he was that kind of person!

He was also a proud member of the Minnesota Patriot Guard, honoring those Veterans with his presence on his motorcycle at their interments at Fort Snelling and other locations and told stories of riding in formation in December on ice to honor one Vet. And those who knew him knew he loved every minute of it all with a real passion for living and life.

As for a memorial service, I believe the family will have a closed family memorial after the holidays but I will keep the club posted if anyone wants to express condolences.

Rest in Peace Ron and we'll get some trigger time together again sometime in the future.

Board Member Nominations

The Nominating Committee has asked for volunteers or recommendations for Board positions for Oakdale Gun Club. The current Board Members in the Treasurer, Trap Director and the Safety/Security Director will not be running for the Board in 2022. All other Board members will be running for reelection.

If you are interested in being considered for any Board position, please fill in the attached application and forward with your photo to secretary@oakdalegunclub.org. Applications must be received ASAP in order to be presented by the Nominating Committee at the November regular membership meeting November 10th, 2021.

The descriptions of each position is included below and is also in the bylaws.

- A. President: The president shall preside at all meetings of the club membership, Board of Directors and the Executive Committee. He/she shall be a member "ex-officio" of all regular and special committees and perform all such duties as are considered appropriate to the office. The president shall oversee and direct the activities of the facility/operations manager.
- B. Vice-President: The vice-president shall perform the duties of the president in his/her absence or at his/her request. The vice-president is responsible for scheduling all facility/range activities and performing such assignments as requested by the president or Board of Directors.
- C. Secretary: The secretary is the focal point for all official club communications. He/she shall notify all club members of regular, special and annual meetings as defined in Article V and all board members of the board of directors' meetings. He/she shall prepare and keep minutes of all regular, board of directors, executive committee and special meetings including a count of the members present at each meeting. He/she shall keep secure and available a true record of all Bylaws, documented policies and procedures, membership lists, and records of the club, except the treasurer's books of accounts. The secretary is responsible for re-affiliating the club annually with the National Rifle Association (NRA) and conducting all official correspondence pertaining to the proper preparation and forwarding of all reports required of the club by the NRA and by the Civilian Marksmanship Program. The secretary is responsible for communicating information to the members via the club newsletter with the assistance of the newsletter director as required.
- D. Treasurer: The treasurer is responsible for the collection of all fees and dues and has charge of all funds of the club which must be placed in such bank or banks that have been approved by the Board of Directors. The treasurer is responsible for payment of all club bills with such payments being made only for bills preapproved by the Board of Directors. Money must be withdrawn from club accounts only by checks signed by the Treasurer and co-signed by the President, Vice-President, or Secretary. A financial status report must be made at all Regular Membership and Annual meetings. It must include details of all disbursements being available for examination at that meeting by any member in good standing. A full year's financial report must be open for examination to any member in good standing after the Annual Meeting.
- E. Building and Grounds Director: The building and grounds director is responsible for the condition of all club property including but not limited to buildings, roads, berms, plantings, natural vegetation, target stands, firing stations and covers, trap machines, fences and gates, caretaker's house, tools and machinery and their associated maintenance records/files. He/she shall coordinate with others in organizing projects and preparing man-hour/cost estimates as necessary for consideration by the Board of Directors and/or the club membership. He/she may appoint other assistants as necessary to perform required projects/tasks. The building and grounds director shall contract no bills in excess of an amount preapproved by the Board of Directors.

Board Member Nominations (Cont.)

- F. Safety and Security Director: The safety and security director is responsible for the safety of activities at the club as well as the physical security and safety of the Oakdale Gun Club range facility. He/she shall further be responsible for the security of club electronic systems and data with the help of the IT director as required.
- G. Chief Instructor: The chief instructor shall be responsible for all training as approved by the Board of Directors. He/she has the authority to appoint assistant instructors as required.
- H. Chief Match Director: The chief match director shall arrange and coordinate, in conjunction with the vice-president for scheduling purposes and with the safety and security director for approval of course of fire, all competitions on the various club ranges with the help of any assistants for specific events which he/she may appoint. He/she shall provide a year-end report of competitive activities. The chief match director may contract, without authorization of the Board of Directors, only those bills directly associated with the printing of scorecards, targets, and other materials as required for competitions.
- I. Marketing and Public Relations Director: The marketing and public relations Director shall be responsible for a positive image presented by Oakdale Gun Club to the general public. He/she shall attend local town/city council meetings in order to keep the membership advised of community sentiments regarding the club. He/she shall interface with the local community and neighbors. He/she shall arrange and oversee all publicity and advertising including but not limited to gun show and summer festival club representation with the help of any assistants he/she may appoint.
- J. Long Range Planning Director: The long-range planning director shall be responsible for organizing and presenting for approval to the Board of Directors and the membership, potential long-term projects regarding major improvements and renovations of facilities. He/she should solicit input from other individuals who are knowledgeable in specific related areas. Project proposals should include a written assessment of associated risks which may need to be addressed along with a strategy for risk mitigation.
- K. Legislative Director: The legislative director shall be responsible for monitoring and interfacing with the State Legislature as well as monitoring the US Congress and Senate to advise the membership of impending legislation, its wording, and the potential effects on the club and its members. He/she shall suggest appropriate follow-up plans, including phone, electronic media and letter campaigns, demonstrations, etc. and report on the eventual disposition of the proposed legislation.
- L. IT Director: The IT director shall be responsible for advising the club concerning information technology application needs. He/she shall be responsible for maintaining the club's computer hardware, software, network, data bases and the club's internet website. He/she shall provide support as requested to the safety and security director in matters of electronic data security.
- M. Newsletter Director: The newsletter director shall be responsible for producing and editing the club newsletter to keep the membership appraised in a timely fashion of scheduled facility/range usage, shooting hours, minutes of Regular, Board of Directors, and special meetings, any club related items affecting a significant number of members. Also, all other such notices as are required by these Bylaws. The results of all votes taken at board meetings must be reported in the newsletter identifying those directors absent, voting in the minority and/or not voting.
- N. Youth Director: The youth director shall be responsible for arranging and overseeing club activities specifically intended for youth including coordinating with the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources concerning youth Firearm Safety Instruction programs.
- O. Trap Director: The Trap Director is responsible to oversee the safe, orderly management and operations of all aspects of the OGC Trap Program. He/she is responsible to modify and implement safety measures and policies across all aspects of the trap operations. He/she is to establish programs to maintain and promote safe shooting events by developing, scheduling and facilitating comprehensive training for Trap Range Safety Officers (RSO), Lead Trap RSO's and trap machine maintenance.

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
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
