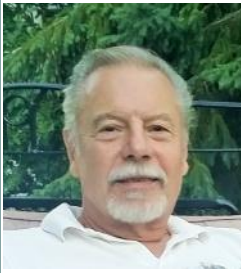

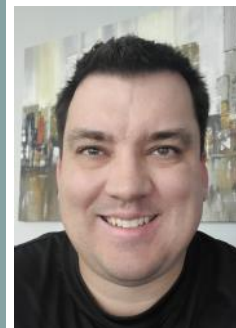

Annual Board of Director Reports for 2020

2020 Marketing Director Report Gail Angone

Installed new Oakdale Gun Club Entrance Sign
Updated, organized, and reformatted content for new OGC website, took new pictures of each range.
Created yearly OGC brochure and other marketing materials.

2020 Trap Director Report Daryll Olson

Amidst another successful year, there are behind the scenes activities going on to enhance the trap range in the future as well obvious changes or improvements.

Trap and RSO Training was conducted again in April for those whose three-year time frame has expired as well as the new members. As usual there are always members who are unable to attend trap and RSO training for various reasons. Therefore, behind the scenes there is some activity going on to create a video for all OGC members to watch at their leisure in lieu of attending the usual Trap land RSO scheduled training. A quiz will also be included.

A spare trap machine has been purchased to use should one go down for an extended period.

All trap machines need to be armed before certain adjustments can be made. Trap one requires one to walk in front of the armed machine to make toe adjustments. Progress is being made to rid the machine of the safety issue. Hopefully, this Spring we will see the change made.

I am trying to get the ground prepared and a storage container for targets. It does not make sense to store pallets of targets in a heated garage, and the location of the container will be closer to the trap range.

I have seen an increase of broken wires in the voice callers. Handles and different carts have been provided to aid in different handling of the voice callers to help reduce the wire breakage.

I have been making inquiries for lead reclamation from the trap range. That could result in a lucrative venture.

2020 Chief Instructor Report Charley Ames

This year we have made some changes to acceptance of new members. First of all, social distancing has limited the number of new members in the classroom for orientation to fifteen. Also, we are now allowing people to join as we receive inquiries from information on our website up until July with their dues prorated. These changes required me to conduct eleven orientation classes this year. The number of new members was 158. I look forward to continuing in my role as Chief Instructor in the coming year as things slowly get back to some sense of normal.

2020 Newsletter Report Neil Diamond

2020 Treasurer Report Bill Gacki

OGC is ending 2020 in a strong financial position similar to the way the club ended 2019. Almost a year ago this was discussed in detail at the annual meeting. In addition to membership fees the primary revenue generating activities at the club are range passes when open to the public, trap range fees and revenue from third parties using the classroom facilities for training. All in, 2020 so far is running slightly ahead of 2019. A few major points should be mentioned:

- ◆ After the year ends, we of course will produce complete financial statements. As has always been the case, the financial statements will be available for review by any member in good standing. Due to COVID, we shall do this in a safe manner.
- ◆ To ensure continued financial strength please send in your 2021 membership dues as soon as you can.
- ◆ Looking ahead to 2021 the club will be in a good position to resume the capital investment program that the Board slowed down in 2020. There will be investment activity in ADA compliance, general upgrade of the property and specific facilities, security and IT.
- ◆ The bill payment and expense reimbursement processes developed in 2020 due to COVID will continue. Under the revised approach bills are being paid more frequently than in prior years (four times a month vs. two). Should you have reimbursements to claim please turn your paperwork in to the office of the General Manager.

2020 Chief Match Director Report Tom Acheson

While not a record setting year, it turned out to not be as bad as could have been forecasted due to the impact of the Covid 19 virus influences.

Some match dates were cancelled but the late May Glock match was re-scheduled for later in the year. In preparation for the event I communicated with a club lawyer to identify our "capacity". I did some calculations to establish the square footage of the portions of the property that would be used. Following the State's "math model", we determined that our event capacity is limited to (234) people at the match at any one time. Reflecting back on previous year's attendance levels, we estimated that the total headcount at any one time was about 150-160 people at the Glock event. Our confidence in conducting a properly Covid 19 compliant event was strong. The State's maximum allowed population at an event was (250) people but it is not clear if that pertains to indoor only or all events. So we erred on the conservative side, knowing we are outdoors but guessing the State's (250) is for indoor gatherings.

As we progressed through late spring and early summer, virus mitigation efforts were a point of focus for our match directors.

Although not a priority in conducting our match program, the financial aspect of 2020 reflects the influences of the virus. The net income from our collection of (10) competitive shooting events (excludes shotgun and high school activities) was down 33.1 % compared to 2019.

We formed a SBDT (Shooting Bench Design Team) to look at optimizing the design of the new shooting benches that will eventually be placed on the 100-yard line. That work is ongoing. Our team includes Jim Trunzo, Ron Kohner, Tom O'Mara, Dean Cody, John Richards, Loren Barber and myself.

Right now each match director is working on putting their 2021 match dates together.

Oakdale Gun Club Board Meeting

November 11, 2020

Meeting opened on ZOOM at 7:30 PM there were 12 Board members and Teresa in attendance. Not present was Tom A and Dan B.

Permit To Carry: Request by 2 instructors to become instructors for PTC at OGC.

After discussion there was a unanimous vote to approve the addition of the two instructors.'

This will bring our instructor count to 8 with 10 as the max. Tom M to contact them tomorrow.

Newsletter position: Tom is concerned there is no candidate for the newsletter position. It is too late to try and get a person for the newsletter before the Ballots go out. Neil indicates he will not leave us high and dry in the interim. Discussion followed about methods to try to get a person for this position. Tom indicated we will address this issue in the December meeting.

Election Process: The President needs to appoint someone to count ballots. Patrick volunteered to be the election judge. He can get anyone else in the club to help him. Herb, Dave and Daryll volunteered to help Patrick process the ballots. Neil indicated he would also help and the newsletter will not go out in December until the ballots have been counted.

ADA actions: Discussed what we are doing for ADA to date. We have held up some of the work due to Covid and the uncertainty of income this year Tom asked for a summary we have done so far. Daryll Herb and Dean are in charge of the projects. Daryll has tentative costs for ADA and safety and building and grounds work to be done. He also indicated, due to the time of year, there are no contractors available to do work. Daryll does have a contractor on his list to get rolling next year. He does have a list of jobs to be done. There has been no construction done this year. Tom Acheson has a list of items to be done to address the drainage issues. The Board will have to look at the jobs to be done and the budget for next year. Daryll indicated he will not be able to address the issues until next year. He wants to look at all the work to be done and be sure when work is done that all items are addressed when there is equipment available. Tom M would like the committee of Daryll, Herb, Dean, Tom A. and Patrick to get together and address the projects, and the cost and timing.

Directors yearly Activity: Tom Mader wanted all the Directors to submit their yearly activity report. Neil has set the deadline for these reports to him by December 1.

Shut down club early: Looking at 7 more days of operation at the club. Several RSO's are scheduled for this time. It would be a hassle to close the range now. We will continue to have the club open till the end of this year's schedule. Several members have called to cancel their time due to Covid. All RSO's working in the club house has to wear masks. Discussion followed on the Covid issue with RSO Duty. If the RSO cannot wear a mask due to health problems they cannot work in the clubhouse. This will follow the guidelines set by the Governor.

COVID 19: Teresa has the authority to release RSO's from duty due to Covid 19 issue. Duane will handle the membership covid issues with service time.

Lloyd Security: Patrick has met with Lloyd's President and others on the range to go over the camera operation on the ranges. They went thru the entire ranges and a solution to our camera problem is coming. We may need to spend some money to add cameras and have a solution by the end of the year.

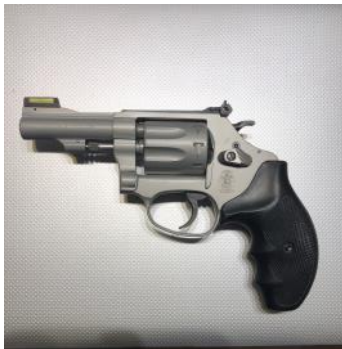
