Oakdale Gun Club Board Meeting

September 9 2020

Meeting opened on ZOOM at 7:30 PM there were 13 Board members and Teresa in attendance.
Not present was Tom E

Lloyd's Security update: Patrick Talked to Lloyd's and they indicated they would like to reach a happy resolution with our contract with them. They will update our camera system with a hard wired system.

RSO and Gate guard: Neil, 10 slots for gate guards filled in less than an hour. Worked to establish a .policy for the gate guards and distributed it to the guards. He added a SignUp Genius signup tab for the Glock match support staff and that was filled in record time also. Neil is working with Teresa to add more time slots to the system for the end of the year. This should handle the requests she has gotten from members. We are fully booked up until the end of service time. Working with the new system for next year to get ahead of the game for service hours signup.

Lighting: Dean. Lighting on the 25 and 50 yard ranges were update to use LED bulbs. Works a lot better now as feed-back has been positive on being able to see the sights.

Fees for 2021: We are currently at \$22 for rifle/pistol shooting on ranges. Per Teresa we are above last year revenue at this time. So there will be no increase for rifle/pistol shooting in 2021 Pat made **Motion** to leave \$22 for public range fee for next year. Second Daryll majority voting aye no negative. Next discussed the trap rates for the High School shoots. After lengthy discussion Pat made a **Motion** for \$5 rate per round for all High Schools shooting trap at OGC. Second Dean majority voting aye no negative. Daryll asked about the need to order birds. Daryll got the OK from Bill to order a full truck load of Birds. Non-member and Member trap fee was discussed next. Neil made **Motion** to set the member trap fee to \$3.00 and non-member trap fee to \$8.00 for 2021. Patrick seconded with majority voting aye no negative. Next discussed the late fee for members renewing late after the January meeting and until February 1 Dean made a **Motion** to increase the penalty to \$75 for members paying late. Bill seconded with majority voting aye and 1 negative. Normally, any increase in member dues would be done at an Annual meeting so membership can vote. There will be no increase in membership dues. Membership dues will remain at \$125 for 2021. Board and Honorary and advisors membership will be \$62.50 for 2021 Initiation fee for new members will not change at \$150 for 2021.

The fee for Concealed carry range use currently is \$20 per student for one hour will not change.
This year has been an extraordinary year with members paying late due to Covid 19.

100yd Baffle certification Discussion took place about the corrosion, welds, and the wear on the baffles. Concern by Tom A, We need to have the baffles certified. Teresa indicated Eugene Crandall would be good to contact. Also Ron Kohler's name was mentioned. Building and Grounds will be following up on this issue.

Annual Meeting Bylaws: Due to covid there is not a way to vote for Bylaw changes this year.
Neil commented on the low percentage of people reading the newsletter.

Boy Scout Badge: Daryll, Member's son wants to replace two plastic tables on the trap range. The Scout is doing this for a badge. He will be using treated lumber. This type of work has been done in the past. Patrick made a **Motion** to have the Scout build 2 benches for the trap range. Daryll seconded with majority voting aye no negative.

Swap Meet: Duane the date is set for Sept 15. The swap meet has 10 members to set up with guns and ammo and lots of extras to sell. There will lots of great deals to be had.

SERVICE HOUR SIGN UP

Service Hour Online SIGN UP New Link:

We are coming to the end of 2020 service hours.

We are using SignUp Genius for online signup of service hours.

- ◆ You will receive a reminder 4 days before your schedule work time.
- ◆ Your work time slot is locked 5 days before your scheduled time slot. You will need to contact newsletter or VP to make changes.
- ◆ Change requests within the 3 day of schedule commitment need to be authorized by GM.

The schedule is dynamic. Slots open and close quickly as Members are rescheduling work slots. Check back often if you have a need to reschedule.

New Members, Make sure you sign up for your 2 work days. These work slots must be for Line RSO.

Process overview:

- ◆ Click on link or paste path in your web browser URL
- ◆ Select the month to view opening. You can change between Month and List view.
- ◆ Find a day with openings (this is easier to see in the calendar mode)
- ◆ Enter your information
- ◆ You will receive a notice confirming your selection
- ◆ 4 days before your service time, you will receive a reminder notice
- ◆ The filled service time slots are locked to changes 5 days before service slot

If you do not have access to the internet, you have a couple of ways to signup.

1. Contact the Newsletter or VP board member to help you signup
2. Have a friend or another member sign up for you. This is done by them adding in your name.

REVIEW OF MEMBER GUEST POLICY

You are the Range Safety Officer for your guests and Family and are not allowed to be shooting at the same time as they are.

Members of your immediate family consisting of your spouse, partner and children may use the club facilities with you. All family members and guests must sign a waiver every time they use the club with you, unless they filled out an annual online waiver from our website. Although, there is no limit to how many immediate family members you bring, you must supervise your family at all times and they must be physically on the same range as you, arrive and leave with you. During “member only” hours, there is no minimum age limit for a shooter (during public hours, all children under 18 years old must show proof of attending DNR FAS). Children must be well behaved and under control at all times. All children must be directly supervised one on one while shooting. Anyone not shooting or directly supervising, must stay behind the yellow line. All family members must wear hearing and eye protection while on the range. **Reminder:** You are your family’s RSO and are not allowed to be shooting at the same time they are.

During “**member-only**” hours, you may bring a maximum of three non-family guests at a time. You must supervise your guests at all times and they must be physically on the same range as you, arrive and leave with you. All guests must wear hearing and eye protection while on the range. **Reminder:** You are your guest RSO and not allowed to be shooting at the same time as the guests.

During **open to the public hours**, your direct Family (spouse, partner and children) may shoot for free on all ranges, BUT must give up their shooting lane immediately if needed for the paying public. This includes both the member and their family. While open to the public, the scheduled RSO’s will be controlling the firing line, therefore the member may be shooting at the same time as their family. A member’s guests (non-immediate family members) must pay to shoot on ranges open to the public. However, the guest may shoot for free on a member only range. **You must supervise your family and guests at all times and they must be physically on the same range as you, arrive and leave with you.**

USA CLAY TARGET LEAGUE SETS NEW RECORD WITH OVER 10,000

For Immediate Release
September 22nd, 2020

ST. PAUL, MN – The USA Clay Target League [3], the nation’s largest youth clay target shooting sport program with over 35,000 athletes in 2019, has set a new Fall Season record with over 10,700 athletes participating, a 25% increase over last fall.

The record-setting participation is after a difficult spring that saw 80% of schools and more than 28,000 athletes unable to participate due to concerns surrounding COVID-19.

“With over 2,500 additional athletes, the fantastic fall participation shows that schools and parents recognize that clay target shooting sports are a safe, low-risk activity.” said John Nelson, President of the USA Clay Target League. “It also shows the dedication and determination of the thousands of coaches and volunteers that donate their time and experience into setting up and managing their local schools’ teams.”

The USA Clay Target League offers Trap, Skeet, Sporting Clays, and 5-Stand leagues to secondary and postsecondary schools across the country. The League is the only 100% school-approved clay target shooting sport program in America.

The League’s co-ed and adaptive nature are key attractions to schools nationwide. The League is fully Title IX compliant with both male and female athletes competing on the same team. Additionally, it’s an ‘adaptive’ sport, which allows students with physical disabilities to take part. The League is also the safest sport in high school and college, with not one reported injury since the inception of the League in 2001. Each athlete must complete firearm safety certification before participation.

“We take pride in that athletes of all types are able to participate,” Nelson said. “Clay target shooting sports are a safe and fun activity that anyone can enjoy.”

The League attracts student athletes to participate in shooting sports while creating a ‘virtual’ competition among teams. Travel is minimal because practice and competition are conducted at a shooting range near the school’s location. Conferences are determined by team size rather than geographic location for fair competition.

Athletes earn True Team® scoring points as determined by their performance and ranking against all athlete scores within their team’s conference. The team score and overall standing are calculated by adding the earned points from qualifying athletes and posted on the League’s website. Athletes and their families track their individual and team performance on their phone, tablet or computer via the Shooter Performance Tracker®.

The USA Clay Target League is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization and is the independent provider of clay target shooting sports for secondary and postsecondary schools. The League’s priorities are safety, fun, and marksmanship – in that order.
