PRESIDENTS NOTES

September 2021

About a week ago I entered the front gate behind a black SUV. He used his card to open the gate and I followed him in. After a few feet down the road he stopped, got out and requested my Club ID. For this I was gratified that a club member was assertive enough to protect all of our interest in a secure facility. I encourage all members to challenge anyone entering the property or shooting on the line to verify their current membership. We all pay a goodly amount for the privilege of shooting at OGC and must do our share to keep unpaid leeches out. I later thanked that member for his diligence.

Now the bad news... This picture is located adjacent to the shotgun patterning board. Recently a member was witnessed using steel shot on the patterning board. The results were severe pock-marks to the steel board necessitating resurfacing to be functional. The member was issued a letter of reprimand and the incident was filed.



I find it difficult to comprehend how someone can abuse our facility right next to a sign prohibiting steel shot. This leads me to mention a conversation I recently had with two long term members who have had discussions with friends and neighbors concerning the number of rules the club operates under. The response of our Security Director is, "this is not a bowling establishment". In order to provide a safe environment to use a broad array of weapons and sustain that right into the future; all possible contingencies must be anticipated and controlled with regulations and barriers. Reasonable regulations create a safe environment for not only members, clients but also the community.

The Building and Grounds Director recently replaced all the plastic sound abatement curtains behind the various ranges. The old curtains were so dirty they could not be cleaned so they were replaced. This allowed natural lighting onto the shooting line. A much-needed improvement.

The September membership meeting is the first chance to present changes or additions to the club's bylaws. If you wish to present changes, I encourage you to read the procedures necessary to make amendments on page 14 of the Official Bylaws found on the website or published Bylaw's pamphlet.

We have been open to the public since early in July and have experienced a lower volume of revenue compared to previous years. This should improve as time passes. Ammunition is becoming more plentiful but expensive. The RSO scheduling is wide open for the month of November.

The path to the scheduling program has been published in the newsletter for the past five months. Check it out and register now.

August 11, 2021

Meeting opened at 7pm by President Tom Mader

The pledge was said.

There were 14 members present.

Secretary Report. Duane read the minutes of the last Board meeting July 14, 2021

VP: Tom B. RSO scheduling for 2021. RSO booked up until October. Still have 15 spots open in October. Have 115 slots open in November. We are in need for people to sign up for November. There will be a Eblast sent out to all member inviting them to sign up for November.

Youth, Terry D. Terry was not able to attend.

Tom M Introduction of the Newsletter Director: Tom Schaeffer, New Board member. Member for about 10 years. Took over Newsletter from Neil in January. Loves to shoot mostly pistols and long rifles. Trying to change things up a little bit for the newsletter. He wants to make sure he is getting the information from the Board out to the members. He has been introducing all the Board members to the membership. Showing pictures of the range to show the modifications in the last two years. His request for the membership is to get information for the newsletter to him early as his biggest pain is getting the info formatted into the newsletter. He would like Information for the newsletter sent to him by the Friday before the last weekend of the month. He is enjoying his time here so far and is looking forward to working with the Board.

ADA coordinator Herb Owen: Trying to get start date for work to get done. Held up on permits and getting materials to do the work. Trying to sync the work with the materials and permits so work doesn't need to be done twice. The storage building on the trap range is his main work right now. Troy, the contractor, is working to get his materials for the building by the trap range and for the ADA work. There has been some work done in removing the trees in the work area.

Toilets: Gail, she explained how we got to where we are now. The committee selected the location inside the storage area next to the classroom. This location would be much cheaper than building new. Phase one is to put in the water lines and tanks needed. The date for this work is set tentatively to start the week of August 23. Currently the contractor is coordinating the work and hopefully it will be completed in a couple of weeks. She has asked the contractor for the drawings of where the water lines and tanks will be, but she has not gotten anything yet.

B&G: Dean Cody was absent, so Tom M commented on his work to replace the plastic strips on the ranges. It was not possible to just clean the plastic it had to be replaced. Dean also indicated he would like to place a roof on the short range but Tom did not have any info on when this would happen.

Pres: Tom M. Had nothing more to add. Question about what type of system would be used on the toilets. It will be a set of tanks that will be pumped when needed. It was asked if the current toilets will have a water line when the new line is built. Gail indicated she will ask the contractor for a possible connection to the current toilet.

Door Prize: A drawing was held for the Door prize at the end of the meeting with Herb Owen winning.

OGC August Board Meeting Minutes

OGC Board Meeting
August 11, 2021

Meeting opened at 7:45PM by President Tom Mader

Present were Duane Wilhelm, Tom Mader. Tom Acheson, Herb Owen, Tom Baker, Gail Angone, Patrick McNeil, and Thomas Schaeffler. Absent were: Daryll Olson, Tom Etzel, Charles Ames, Dean Cody, Bill Gacki, and Terrence Drossier.

Pres. Tom M. started the meeting with thank you to the Board members for all the hours they have worked. Tom indicated there is a request for donation to the Marine Lake Vets Camp.

Discussion followed on the amount to donate and what we have done in the past.

Motion was made to donate \$500 to the Marine Lake Vets Camp. Seconded all voting aye.

High School Trap: Chris Radecki responded to the request that high schools provide their own gate guards. Chris started out by saying thanks to OGC for their support of the trap program. He talked about the High School trap tournament that will be Saturday August 21. There are 45 to 50 kids from all High Schools. There will be awards presented to the top shooters. He also talked about creating a plaque to represent the tournament results and displaying it at the gun club. The plaque would be funded by the tournament funds. About the gate guard's issue Chris proposed any teams shooting outside the Saturday and Sunday time, when we are open to the public, should provide their own gate guards. High School league shoots starts in September. Tom M asked for the proposal in writing for the procedure to follow for gate guards for High School league shoots. Patrick asked if another gate switch could be placed in the new trap storage building to control entry during the shoot. The electric for the new building would not be done until next year so the gate switch could be installed then.

Liability Waiver: Patrick M. the Liability Waiver and the 4H shoots contract was submitted to the lawyer. He has Emailed the results from the Lawyer to the Board members. Tom B. pointed out some corrections that should be made. Tom Acheson brought up the additions he would like added to the waiver about negligence. Discussion followed about the language in the document. Tom A insisted on adding his changes to the waiver. Patrick will send the new waiver with Tom A additions to the Attorney. We will look at it in another month.

IT Review: Where are we? There is a conflict with Tom E. and Neil Diamond on the web site. The Web people will not communicate with Tom E. only with Neil. Tom E suggests we terminate the current contract and get someone else. Gail spoke about her interaction with the current vendor and her difficulties trying to get any info from them. She got the contract from Neil and wants to know who owns the rights to the web site. The contract states the vendor owns the rights until they turn over the site to us. She is not confident with the vendor and will talk to Neil to see if we can get the rights and software. Tom M talked about the conflicts we have had in the past with vendors in getting a workable website for the club. Tom M wants Tom E to know he has the Board support to go forward. Tom M will be writing a letter to Tom E about this issue.

Next Month meeting: Think about the 2022 fee schedule that will be established next month.

GM: Revenue is down 50percent from last year.

Security: Patrick M. working with Lloyd Security to get the work needed. Their attorney has been very unresponsive. Lloyd has responded they will be here tomorrow to run wire on all ranges and replace one camera by the end of the week.

Discussed: Talked about current environment with guns and lack of ammo. State Fair has cancelled all gun shows at the fairgrounds.

Be sure to submit items for the agenda a week before next meeting.

Motion to adjourn Meeting adjourned. 8:27PM.

Indoor Restroom Facility Update

- A committee (Tom Baker, Dean Cody, Herb Owen and Gail Angone) have been working this year with a contractor on building new indoor restroom facilities including ADA accommodations.
- The committee initially looked at improving the existing restrooms outside the club house, then looked at portable restrooms on a trailer and then investigated building new versus modifying an existing building.
- The committee concluded modifying an existing building would be most cost effective and the site chosen was building new restrooms in a portion of the garage next to the classroom.
- Meetings, architectural drawings, cost estimates were presented and a decision came last month by the Board giving approval to start the project in 2 phases.
- Phase 1 will be running water lines from the existing well to the garage building and installing a 3 tank waste system behind the classroom. This includes some upgrades to the current well.
- Work on doing Phase 1 is estimated to start the week of August 23, 2021.
- Work on Phase 2 ... building the actual restrooms within the garage will be started early in 2022.
- This is a long overdue project for the club and we're excited to get it done.

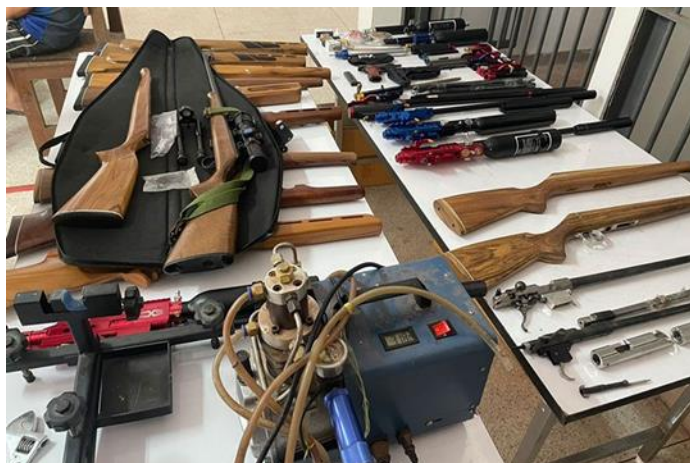
