PRESIDENTS NOTES

October 2021

As you read this construction is beginning on the trap range storage building. This building was necessary to provide room for the new indoor toilets which are to be located in the storage facility presently used for clay bird storage next to the classroom. Phase one of this new toilet facility is the septic system and water source, which is being installed currently. Phase two, the inside construction, is planned for next year. As October progresses you will see improvements on all ranges to facilitate wheelchair access. This will be in the form of limited sloping ramps and stable pathways from the shooting positions to the targets. The lighting on all the ranges was vastly improved by the replacement of the sound abatement plastic strips behind the shooting line. The new clear plastic liners and the addition of LED lights above the benches increased the lighting manyfold.

Revenue from public shooting is half of previous years and is expected to be a bit off due to the shortage of ammunition. Looking ahead, this will cause some reductions in spending and a little belt tightening next year.

Door prize given at the monthly membership meeting is \$20. Be there on the second Wednesday of each month.

A reminder to all Range Safety Officers (RSO): Your obligation starts at 7:00 AM and is a full nine hours. Half-day obligations are not allowed for security and scheduling reasons. The first hour is a debriefing in the registration building by the General Manager or Lead RSO to set up the safety and management for the day. If you have a legitimate medical issue and cannot serve a full shift contact the Secretary for resolution.

OGC September Member Meeting Minutes

OGC Member Meeting SEPTEMBER 08, 2021

Meeting opened at 7pm by Secretary Duane Wilhelm. Both the Pres and VP were absent.

The pledge was said.

There were 25 members present.

Secretary Report. Duane read the minutes of the last Board meeting August 11, 2021.

Minutes were approved as read with no changes.

B&G Status: Dean Cody gave a list of projects completed on the range. Plastic strips have been replaced on the ranges. This has increased the light coming into the range and helped with the sound. The 200yd range has new lighting which helped in shooting on that range. The grading done early this spring has helped with the water problems on the ranges.

Restroom: Gail, report given by Herb. There are some colored lines on the driveway to indicate the utility lines into the classroom. The underground water pipe installation has begun with pipe termination now in the closet in the building. They will be removing the trees behind the classroom to be able to place the waste tanks. The objective is to accomplish all the outside work this year and the inside work saved for next year. Patrick asked about the utility lines.

We should be sure to record where the lines are for future reference. Patrick was also concerned about the conduit running behind the storage building where the tanks are to be installed. The conduit should not be damaged as we don't know what electrical is contained in them or what would have to be fixed if damage occurs.

RSO Scheduling: per Teresa, October is full. There are 5 openings in November. Could use a few more. Looks good for now.

Bylaw changes. Duane read the procedures to follow for presentation of Bylaw changes this year. There were no changes presented.

Trap: Daryll, new trap range building for trap storage is going to be constructed. The materials for the new building will be delivered on the sept 15 with construction beginning on Sept 20.

Door Prize: A drawing was held for the Door prize at the end of the meeting with Craig Bonn winning.

OGC September Board Meeting Minutes

OGC Board Meeting September 08, 2021

Meeting opened at 7:30PM by Secretary Duane Wilhelm

Board present were Duane Wilhelm, Tom Acheson, Herb Owen, Patrick McNeil, Tom Etzel, Charles Ames Daryll Olson, Dean Cody and Terrence Drossier. Absent were: Thomas Schaeffer, Bill Gacki, Tom Mader, Tom Baker, and Gail Angone.

USPA pistol league: Joe Griffin. Joe indicated this is the Thursday night USPA Match. He presented \$2335 in profit to the club. He then gave the following statistics: There were 500 entries for the matches. Of this 26 were club members. They number of rounds fired for a member for a match was 86. The total number of round fired for all matches by a single member was 1106 rounds. This equals a total of 46,795 rounds fired by all members for all the matches. A member asked about how many pounds of lead this was and someone estimated about ½ ton of lead. Jim was happy with the match totals given the COVID problems we have had.

Issue of High School fall shooting gate guard: This would be for July 26 on. This issue was brought up The High School would be responsible for a gate guard when shooting during the week when not open to the public. An Email was read sent to Tom Mader and Baker from Chris Radecki about this issue that proposed a policy for a gate guard when High School would be shooting.

Trap: Daryll proposed a possible special badge for High School shooters to come out to the range and only shoot trap but be able to get into the gate and not have a need for a gate guard. After discussion the opinion of the members was it would not work because the High School kid could bring in their friends and also not having an adult present to monitor what was going on.

Discussion followed on what would we do if the gate guard does not show up for the trap session?

Have also had an incident in the pass when someone went past the gate guard

and was not a member. Terry D. indicated the gate guard did follow the person and ask him to leave. This issue will be addressed further in other meetings.

Fee schedule for 2022: First fee was Dues. Which would remain the same as \$125 for regular members and \$62.50 for Board and Associates. The New member initiation fee will remain the same at \$150.00. Public shooting on the range will not change at \$22.00. Trap fee will not change with \$3.00 for members and \$8.00 for non-members. All the High Schools will pay the same fee of \$5.00 per round.

Dues Proposal: Teresa, Bill asked her to present due to the reduced revenue we have this year, that she proposes the members renew their membership early. She will be placing the 2022 membership renewal forms in the October newsletter. Everyone was in favor of this proposal.

Liability Waiver: Patrick several people were on the phone call with the Lawyers about the Liability waiver. He believed everyone on the call agreed to accept the waiver that has been proposed to the Board. Discussion followed about the waiver. Teresa asked about addition of the waiver for the public to sign. Patrick indicated everyone on the range should sign the waiver when we are open to the public and the waivers would be put in a folder and held for 6 years per the lawyer. We should also create a drop box for anyone coming to the range that is not a member and be sure they sign a waiver and place it in the drop box. The Guest rules at the club would have to be updated to reflect this procedure.

Patrick made a **motion** to pass the two waivers (Group waiver and Individual waiver) proposed to the board. Tom A seconded it with all present voting aye.

Rule of 75: Tom A, Teresa answered his questions already.

Insurance: Terry D. asked about the liability insurance that covers the Board. This was deferred to talk to Bill about the amount of coverage we have for Board members.

Motion to adjourn Meeting adjourned. 8:17PM.

I acknowledge and understand that any activity on the Premises, including but not limited to, the use of firearms or other weapons and being near others handling firearms or other weapons, are inherently hazardous and dangerous activities and involve the risk of serious injury, disability, death, and/or property damage. Notwithstanding the risk, I acknowledge that I am voluntarily participating in the activity with knowledge of the danger involved and agree to accept and assume any and

all risks of injury, disability, death, and/or property damage, arising from my participation in any activity on the Premises, whether caused by the ordinary negligence of OGC or its agents or employees. I hereby expressly elect to voluntarily participate as a member, non-member participant, and/or guest of OGC, in activities on the Premises, in spite of knowing the risks and dangers.

Releaser hereby expressly waives and releases any and all claims, now known or hereafter known, against OGC, and its officers, directors, employees, agents, representatives, affiliates, shareholders, successors, and assigns (collectively, "Releasees"), on account of injury, disability, death, or property damage arising out of or related to my participation in any activities on, or my presence on, the Premises, whether arising out of the ordinary negligence of OGC, its agents or employees, or any Releasees, or otherwise.
