OGC October Member Meeting Minutes

OGC Member Meeting January 12, 2022

Meeting started at 7:00 PM by President Tom Mader. Pledge was said. The meeting started with introductions of the new Board members The following gave a brief bio of his qualifications. Michael Schissl Legislative Director Joe Charchenko Youth Director Jack DeMarre Security Director Eric Hollan Trap Director Daryll Olson Treasure. He was out sick.

Accounting: outsource Tasks will be outsourced to an accounting firm. Daryll sent a letter to Tom M explaining the new mechanical procedure for checks by our accounting firm. This is a firm that we have been using for about 15 years and will have some new duties. The Treasure will be processing our bills and send them to the firm that will enter our info into Quick Books, writing checks, and sending the checks to the Treasure. The Treasure will approve the checks, sign them, and insure the required 2 signatures are done prior to mailing. Daryll also indicated we should have enough funds to cover the Bathroom completion this year. We are down about 35% revenue from previous years and will be watching the budgets closely.

Range improvements: We are working on ADA compliance. There are lawyers targeting businesses that are not ADA compliant. They look for ADA persons that can file suits against us.

We had a company that looks at ADA compliance come to the club and assess our compliance.

We are working on the items they pointed out. We do have contracts to do the work required. The drain field and septic tanks have been done for the bathrooms along with the water line. Dean has updated the lighting on the ranges and replaced the plastic curtains on the range covers.

This has made a significant difference on the lighting on ranges.

Annual Picnic: discussed the date for the picnic this year. The date picked was June 25. This will be before we are open to the public so it will eliminate that conflict. Discussed events from previous Picnics. Some of the events such as cut of two by fours will on not be done due to cost of ammo and low attendance.

Drawing: voted to have two drawings of \$10 each. Winners were Mike Schissl and Jack DeMarre.

OGC October Board Meeting Minutes

OGC Board Meeting January 12, 2022

Meeting started at 7:35 PM by President Tom Mader.

Ron Kohner: addressed the board on his concern about outsourcing the club's financial Operating procedures without the approval of the membership. He wanted the procedures Voted on by the membership at the next member meeting with prior notification of the meeting in the newsletter. Dean Cody pointed out that there was no Bylaw that would require the vote. Dean indicated the normal attendance at the meetings is about 20 people out of 1300. Dean indicated the procedures that will be used has been approved by the Board that has the responsibility for the financials of the club. Dean asked if it would be all right to put the new financial procedures in the newsletter as informing the members of what is changing. Gayle indicated she did not believe this was necessary as that is what the Board of Directors do for the entire club. She did not believe there would be a consensus by the membership. Charlie said we could put the procedure in the next meeting if they have questions. Tom E indicated this was talked about at the annual meeting and also was in the prior month's newsletter. This is not a change in the procedure as it is a change in who enters the information in Quick Books. Ron K did not believe there should be changes to the Bylaws for this matter. The Executive Board has looked at this last summer and recommended the change.

Newsletter, Thomas Schaeffler, has published bios of all the Board. He would like bios of the new members of the Board. He welcomes pictures of history of the club, articles relating to members hobbies, any pictures of Youth activity at the club, or members interests. He would like them a week before the newsletter is published usually the last weekend of the month.

Bill Gacki acknowledgement: After discussion it was decided to honor Bill with 5yrs of dues waver and a plaque. This was approved by the Majority of the Board.

Bank Authorizations: Multiple authorization are required by 8 organizations we do business with. Per the Bylaws the checks must be signed by the Treasure and co-signed by the President, Vice President, and Secretary. Majority of the Board approved the bank authorizations as above. Tom M and others to meet at the organizations and update the Authorizations required.

Audit: Bill Gacki requested an audit of the club. He recommended going back 3 years. We will hire an audit firm later in the year as the cost is less after their busy season.

President: Tom M. Bill indicated the revenue is down 35% from previous years due to ammo and covid problems. Tom M will be calling all the Board member to ask for their budget for the year. Per Tom M we will continue to Finish building the bathrooms this year. Also, we will be putting money into the software we use (IT, Tom Etzel). We will also look at the youth as this is the future of the club. We do have money to spend but we will be careful of what we spend. There is a request by an Eagle Scout to build an Archery range at the club. There is a nice range next door in the Washington county Park we would be competing with. Tom to contact the scout via a letter for alternative project he could do for his Eagle Scout project. The scout can contact Dean Cody for ideas.

Raffle Tickets: H.S. trap asking to sell raffle tickets to club members. Tom M to get more information on this issue.

Future BOD meeting. We may not have future meetings every month as the Bylaws only require meeting Quarterly. There can be more meeting using zoom or Emails. We need to have a rapid meet at times as need arises. We will table this until next meeting with Tom E info.

New members: Duane indicated January, March and May will be the only times we will accept new members. This will allow the new members to sigh up for the service hours and ease scheduling by Tom Baker and Teresa.

2022 Introduction to Firearms for Women

Do you want to learn about handguns, rifles and shotguns?

This 1 evening + 1 day informational workshop, taught by certified safety instructors, is a way for Women to get their basic questions about firearms answered in a safe, friendly, casual, women-only classroom environment.

Note: Instructors are both Female and Male.

The workshop consists of one evening and one full day: evening is classroom discussion and Saturday morning is "hands on". Then experience an afternoon of live fire range time on Saturday afternoon. You do not need to have any previous shooting experience to take this class or own a firearm.

A wide variety of firearms will be provided at no extra cost for those who wish to try them during the range session. This course neither promotes the ownership of firearms nor will any be offered for sale during the course. This class is open to the public. You must be at least 18 years of age to take this class, unless accompanied by a parent. Other restrictions may apply.

The cost of this course is \$50.00 (includes: class materials, firearm rentals and ammo) and must be prepaid to hold your registration. The class is limited to 30 women on a first come basis.

This class is only held once a year.

The 2022 Class has been scheduled.

Wednesday April 27th from 5:30pm to 9pm in the classroom at OGC

Saturday April 30 th 9:00am-5:00pm-from 9:00am-12:00pm "hands-on" in the classroom with lunch 12p-1p (you may bring your own or leave for lunch) then 1:00 pm to 5:00pm shoot one-on-one with instructors on the range.

You must attend both Wednesday evening and Saturday's morning class to be able to shoot on the range Saturday afternoon.



History of NRA Conventional Pistol Shooting @ OGC

There are no formal records to tell us exactly when OGC held its first match. The club began in 1964. Jack Paige, an ex Marine, was highly interested in the sport. He was the club's first Executive Officer. (Roger Glass was number two after Jack died of liver cancer, and I became number three in 1979 after Roger died of brain cancer, and then the title was changed to Chief Match Director, probably due to Stan Durda's push for OGC to become more "business oriented").





There are two large pistol shooting championship plaques in the back of the classroom. One is for Outdoor Pistol (NRA Conventional Pistol, Bullseye or 2700) and the other plaque recognizes Gallery Pistol shooting. Since Gallery is usually conducted indoors, and OGC does not conduct indoor shooting, the Outdoor plaque is the one I looked at. Brent Larson's name appears as the 1966 winner. I'm not sure but I think he passed on. But he was very active in the OGC Bullseye program over the early years.





With the club forming in 1964, I'm projecting the club took two years to construct the Competition range, including installing a target turning mechanism. So we'll use 1966 as the first year of Bullseye shooting @ OGC, connected to Brent's 1966 win. This is our oldest organized shooting event. The second oldest is handgun silhouette.

WHAT IS THE POSTAL MATCH??

POSTAL MATCH

The OGC Postal Match is great fun, gives shooters a goal to achieve as well as a reason to practice and improve his / hers shooting skills. The term "Postal" refers to the manner by which targets are exchanged, the US Mail. The Postal Match works like this;

Shooters choose only the events they want to participate in. Fee per event is \$5.00 and the deadline for entries is June 15, 2022.

The events are:

Handgun (Revolver) @ 10 Yards, open sights, timed fire.
Handgun (Autoloader) @ 10 Yards, open sights, timed fire.
Handgun (Rimfire) @ 10 Yards, open sights, timed fire.
Handgun Unlimited 100 Yards, any caliber, any sight.
Lever Action @ 100 Yards, scope, timed fire.
Lever Action @ 100 Yards, iron sights, timed fire.
Rimfire Rifle @ 100 Yards, scope, timed fire.
Rimfire Rifle @ 50 Yards, open/iron sights, timed fire.
Hunting Rifle (.270 Min Cal) @ 100 Yards, scope, timed fire.
Hunting Rifle (.270 Min Cal) @ 100 Yards, iron sights, timed fire.
Varmint Rifle @ 200 Meters, scope, timed fire.
Varmint Rifle @ 200 Meters iron sights, timed Fire
Black Powder Cartridge Rifle @ 200 yards. Scope, timed fire.

Your official Postal Match Targets and specific event rules will be mailed to you within 10 days. You have all summer to complete your events using the honor system. When you have completed your events, return the score targets, by US mail, to Don Nelson at the above address by September 15, 2022.

The top shooter in each event will receive his/her \$5.00 Grand Prize and, of course, have bragging rights knowing he or she is "TOP GUN" in the OGC Postal Match. In addition, the top competitor in each of the thirteen events will be recognized in the OGC Newsletter.
