Restrooms: Gail, Plumbing and electric is ruffed in, Sheet rock is in process. Duct work needs to be done. Heater will be installed in door area. Signs, water piping on well, ADA requirements for door are being addressed.

Archery: Herb and Dean were absent so no action.

Scheduling: VP, right now are about 80 percent full. 280 slots are still open. Everyone seems to wait until the last moment. Will be sending out an Email blast soon.,

ADA status: Herb absent,

Speakers in storage: We have speaker system found in storage. No one seems to know where it came from. Duane indicated there was a system bought years ago for better audio at the meetings. There were some suggestions for its use.

GM: new credit card process has been purchased with help from club member input. Have new Credit card machine working now. Should save club between 8 and \$10,000 this year. Getting ready for public opening including First Aid equipment on ranges, new banner in front of range gate.

Drawing: voted to have two drawings of \$10 each. Winners were #13 Joe griffin and #5 Bill Vos.

OGC Board Meeting

JUNE 8, 2022

Meeting started at 7:22 by VP Tom baker in the absence of Pres. Tom Mader.

There were 8 Board members present and the GM.

Glock Match: Jim Finch the Glock Match director gave the report on the Glock match this year. 2022 was a success with 233 entries verses 256 last year, maybe due to cost increases. This was the 30th consecutive Glock match advertised by Glock as longest consecutive match at same facility. 3 Glock people came from Atlanta for match. There were no safety problems and only one mishap with a fall by Richard Scheffler on the path on the short range, he was OK. Jim Gave Teresa \$1190.74 as proceeds from the match for the club. Thanks to the 40 club members that worked the match. Also, thanks to Joe Biden for the cost increases. There was a problem with the gate guard duties that was resolved. Thanks to co-directors Joe and Zack. They reported everything went smoothly. Zack did a great job taking care of the Range Officers with coffee. Jim said next year he will consider increasing number of tickets sold per gun to off set expenses.

Security: Jack, had minor problem and when called Lloyds asked about replacing our server as it is old and obsolete. \$3500 to reuse with updates of server. Talked about \$3400 to install camera by house on a light pole. \$1200 for restroom security. Old server working now but new server is \$3600. After discussion the total for all updates would be \$11970.00 for all cameras and server. Discussed the options available and looking at cost for bathroom completion. Looking at all expenses and income to date. Will replace server for now.

BOD status: Trap Director open: Lou had volunteered for trap director. Discussion followed about procedure to appoint a director and process to follow. It was decided to hold on appointing a director now pending advertising the Trap Director position in the next newsletter and possibly an Eblast. This will be handled in the next membership meeting.

Discussed a problem with the link for trap training, VP to coordinate.

Second Gate for Gate Guard replace: Cost is too high verses using member as guard.

Trap Video: Tom Mader discussed getting a video for trap training. Joe Morino had done this in the past. Will contact him for help.

4H liability: this issue has been resolved.

Sign-up Genius: Currently we are paying \$29 per month for this. Will leave it for now.

Prizes: Several prizes have been donated. Tom M also found Amp and speaker in the back room. Will offer amp to the membership first in the newsletter.

Motion to adjourn 08:25 PM Meeting adjourned.
