OGC March Member Meeting Minutes

OGC Member Meeting Mar 08, 2023

Meeting started at 7:00 PM by President Gail Angone.

There were 23 members present.

The Pledge was said at the start the meeting.

Secretary Report: The minutes of the last meetings (February) were read. There were no corrections. Minutes accepted as read.

Treasure Report: Daryll gave the report on our finances as of February. He also reported on the utilities paid, loan payments, taxes, Payroll, IT, member renewals. There are only 2 people with club credit cards. There was a question by Dean about having credit cards at Lake Elmo Bank. Daryll will look at what expenses we have and the best way to pay. For now, we will use the cards we have.

Grant money: Herb, Gail, and Barry are applying for grant money. The grants require numbers of youth we support, Youth Director, Joel, gave student numbers as High School trap 305, DNR field day 100, Hunter safety 200, NRL22 event 220, and Action shooting team 14. Herb

is working on a cover letter and description for a grant. Barry is working on On-line information to prep the grant. Joel indicated he needs equipment for hunter safety like: Turkey blinds, waterfowl blinds, and elevated deer stands. Gail said we would be pursuing two grants splitting it up between the Hunter safety needs and Trap range improvements like flooding problems and the new trap house. We will try for the two for now as there is lots of competition for the grants.

Member Don Nelson: came to the meeting to talk about the club policy of staying out of political issues. He had a couple of ideas the club could get involved in. One is to invite the Mn gun Caucus to come to a club meeting and talk about the gun issues. The other is to have the club provide transportation to the capital for the rally on March 25. This would be very subtle just facilitating getting our members to the event. Gail said we discussed this and talked about having the Mn Gun Caucus come to the club. Byron also indicated we have invited them to the picnic and have given them several dates to come to the club. They have not responded yet and we believe they are very busy with the issues. Gail said we need a separation here as we have to think of our club. We are a business and are tied to the Lake Elmo community. We are all adults and know who to put our support behind. Dean said we could send out an Eblast to inform the members of the March 25 rally but not provide buses to the rally. Our history of the club is to not be political. More discussion followed about us being more informative on political issues to our members. A lot of us don't know how to respond to these issues. The media puts out all kinds of problems with gun violence but do not address the multitude of sportsman that own guns. We will discuss this more at the Board meeting.

Trauma Center Instruction: Joel contacted Mercy hospital to conduct training for our members.

First will be to invite the RSO members, Board members, Coaches and then members. There is a limit to the number based on classroom size.

Service hours signup: Byron, as of this date 652 member slots have been filled and 40 new member slots. There are openings for later in the year.

Badges: Jack, working this week to get 2023 member badges created. He will be picking times for members to pick up their 2023 badges at the club. Teresa helps with creating the badges.

House Cleaner: Has one person in doing their service hours cleaning the house and organizing the items stored at the house.

B&G: Dean, would like to get a new snowblower and lawnmower this year. Looking at where to put snow on the ranges during the winter. He talked about contributing to Granite House by the club. Last year due to Covid, we eliminated any donations. The Board needs to establish a new policy for donations.

Picnic: have info on all the ranges for picnic signup.

Drawing: voted to have two drawings of \$10 each. Winners were #10 Darwin Gebhardt and #21 Tom Schaeffer.

people that come out to shoot on the range. What about 18- to 20-year-old members? What about Wisconsin members? There are several issues with this requirement for membership that we have no control over. We will check with Tom Baker to see what a commercial gun range does.

EPA: Tom Baker sent info about gun range requirements. Need to look at our management of lead on the range.

House Classroom: Hold for now on the basement classroom.

Will look for future possible use.

A small class could be held in one of the bedrooms if needed. Lots of rugs in the house now. Gail suggested vinyl flooring for ease of cleaning. Daryll volunteered to put down tile. Need to get an estimate of cost.

On going: Insurance review, compare costs. Look at our bills like comcast, phone etc. Start bylaws discussion.

2023 Introduction to Firearms for Women

Public Welcome!! At: Oakdale Gun Club 10386 – 10th St. North, Lake Elmo, MN

Do you want to learn about handguns, rifles and shotguns?

This 1 evening + 1 day informational workshop, taught by certified safety instructors, is a way for Women to get their basic questions about firearms answered in a safe, friendly, casual, women-only classroom environment.

Note: Instructors are both Female and Male.

The workshop consists of one evening and one full day: evening is classroom discussion and Saturday morning is "hands on". Then experience an afternoon of live fire range time on Saturday afternoon.

You do not need to have any previous shooting experience to take this class or own a firearm.

A wide variety of firearms will be provided at no extra cost for those who wish to try them during the range session. This course neither promotes the ownership of firearms nor will any be offered for sale during the course. This class is open to the public. You must be at least 18 years of age to take this class, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian. Other restrictions may apply.

The cost of this course is \$50.00 (includes: class materials, firearm rentals and ammo) and must be prepaid to hold your registration. The class is limited to 30 women on a first come basis.

This class is only held once a year.

The 2023 Class has been scheduled.

Wednesday June 7th from 5:30pm to 9pm in the classroom at OGC

Saturday June 10th 9:00am-5:00pm: from 9:00am-12:00pm "hands-on" in the classroom with lunch 12p-1p (you may bring your own or leave for lunch) then 1:00 pm to 5:00pm shoot one-on-one with instructors on the range.

You must attend both Wednesday evening and Saturday's morning class to be able to shoot on the range Saturday afternoon.

The NRA calls it Precision Pistol, some call it 2700 The shooters call it BULLSEYE!

Oakdale Gun Club – 10386 10th Street North, Lake Elmo MN 55042

What is Bullseye or Conventional Pistol?

"Bullseye" is the classic precision pistol sport. Shooters fire at targets one-handed, while standing in the classic "dueling" posture, at distances of 25 and 50 yards. A complete match consists of 270 shots fired at a variety of 10-ring targets, with the best possible score being 2700 points - hence a match is often referred to as a "2700".

The match is traditionally shot using three pistols - .22 rimfire, a centerfire handgun (typically a .38 revolver), and a .45 semi-automatic handgun. However, modern .45 semi-auto handguns are so accurate that most competitors skip using a separate gun for the centerfire stage and just use their .45 for both the "centerfire" and ".45" stages.

Targets are mounted on rotating stands so that they can be turned to be visible to the shooter for a limited amount of time. A match is divided into three 90-shot events and four stages: slow fire, the "National Match Course", timed fire, and rapid fire. The slow, timed, and rapid-fire stages are 20-shots each, while the "National Match Course" consists of 30 shots: 10 slow fire shots at 50 yards, and 10 each in timed and rapid fire at 25 yards. Timed fire consists of 5 rounds in 20 seconds, while rapid fire consists of 5 rounds in 10 seconds.


2023 Three Position Rifle Matches

These matches develop proficiency in firing for score in Sitting, Kneeling, and Standing positions. Any repeating rifle, rimfire or center fire, qualifies. There are no requirements or limitations to equipment. Any sight, any action, any modification allowed.

The match comprises 50 rounds at 50 yards; 10 rounds each slow and rapid fire Sitting, 10 rounds slow fire Kneeling, and 10 rounds each slow and rapid fire Standing. Low velocity jacket or cast bullet reloads are suggested for reduced cost and recoil. Score your own targets. Rotate between different guns during the season if you wish.

2023 matches are May 3, June 7 & 21, July 5 & 19, Aug. 2 & 16, and Sept. 6 & 20. Open practice at 5:00 pm, match starts at 5:30 pm and lasts about an hour. Targets are supplied. Match fee is \$5.

In the event of inclement weather (rain or muddy conditions at the range as a result of rain), the match will be canceled. For more info about the match or cancellations, call Linda Ruffing (651) 731-1714 or Denis LaCroix (651) 488-2615.

WHAT IS THE POSTAL MATCH??

The OGC Postal Match is great fun, gives shooters a goal to achieve as well as a reason to practice and improve his / hers shooting skills. The term "Postal" refers to the manner by which targets are exchanged, the US Mail. The Postal Match works like this;

Shooters choose only the events they want to participate in. Fee per event is \$5.00 and the dead-line for entries is June 15, 2023.

The events are:

Handgun (Revolver) @ 10 Yards, open sights, timed fire.

Handgun (Autoloader) @ 10 Yards, open sights, timed fire.

Handgun (Rimfire) @ 10 Yards, open sights, timed fire.

Handgun Unlimited 100 Yards, any caliber, any sight.

Lever Action @ 100 Yards, scope, timed fire.

Lever Action @ 100 Yards, iron sights, timed fire.

Rimfire Rifle @ 100 Yards, scope, timed fire.

Rimfire Rifle @ 50 Yards, open/iron sights, timed fire.

Hunting Rifle (.270 Min Cal) @ 100 Yards, scope, timed fire.

Hunting Rifle (.270 Min Cal) @ 100 Yards, iron sights, timed fire.

Varmint Rifle @ 200 Meters, scope, timed fire.

Varmint Rifle @ 200 Meters iron sights, timed Fire

Black Powder Cartridge Rifle @ 200 yards. Scope, timed fire.


