Update from President – August 2023

New Policy: Oakdale Gun Club Confidential Information Policy for Board of Directors and All of Oakdale Gun Club Membership

It is the policy of the Oakdale Gun Club that all club membership will not disclose confidential information belonging to, or obtained through their affiliation with, the Oakdale Gun Club to any person outside of membership, or any business and professional associates, unless the Oakdale Gun Club has authorized disclosure. This policy is not intended to prevent disclosure where disclosure is required by law.

Preservation of privileged information: Board members and all club membership shall not divulge, transmit or distribute any confidential or proprietary information outside of the club's membership without Oakdale Gun Clubs authorized disclosure. Any disclosure of the Oakdale Gun Club Confidential and Proprietary Information may put the club at risk. Proven violations may have consequences and will be handled by the Executive Committee.

The following indicates important confidential and proprietary information. This policy may be updated to cover additional information deemed confidential and proprietary. This policy will reside in the Member Handbook.

- Bylaws are considered a legal document that dictates how the organization must be governed thus are a confidential document of the club.
- The club's financial, legal and security information, insurance policies, tax documents, member issues/discipline, employee records/compensation, the contents of the membership E-Bulletin/Newsletter which contains board and member meetings, contact lists, project info and firearm sales, all policy and procedural manuals, the member handbook, project plans, and contracts.

Marketing tools such as the club's website, club brochures and classroom materials are intended for public viewing and not considered confidential info of the club.

Social Time: Tom Acheson wants to start having a social half hour before the meeting. If there is a particular topic you would to discuss more about we are open to topics such as learning more about the CMP, M1 Garand, etc. let Tom know.

IT Report: Tom Etzel noted that the MN DNR and the NRA both had no or outdated information listed and provided them with corrected information to post on the websites.

TRAP TALK

Trap Tip of the Month Know the rules:

When you are shooting trap and you chip a bird, but the score keeper calls a loss- raise your hand **immediately** and tell them you had a chip. If this is not disputed right away and the next shooter takes their shot, you can't go back later and make a dispute. Majority rules in this case, its up to a vote amongst the squad to determine if the dispute is warranted.

Remember:A shot near the target, can steer the target- but does not mean you hit the target. There must be a chip to count as a hit.

Just a Friendly Reminder:

While shooting on a range that is being used for public shooting;

- The Range Safety Officers have command of the ranges and Trap area.
- Anyone under the age of 18 must show proof that they have completed DNR FAS Training.
- Your guest(s) must pay. This does not include direct Family members, but you must give up your shooting position if needed for a public shooter.
- 1 Bullseye type target only. You may bring a target that has multiple bullseyes on it, but it must be approximately the same size as the ones we sell to the public (14"x18")
- Only 1 uncased gun at the point of fire at a time.
- No kneeling or prone shooting.
- No holster draw.
- OGC Badge must be worn in plain sight at all times.
- The Range Safety Officers have command of the ranges and Trap area


