OGC June Member Meeting Minutes

OGC Member Meeting June 14, 2023

Meeting started at 7:001 PM by President Gail Angone.

There were 21 members present.

Secretary Report: Duane read the minutes from the May 10 Member and Board meeting. They were approved as read.

Accounting System: Gail commented on the search for a new accounting business for us to use. We have not signed any papers yet. We are accumulating information on the items we and the accounting business we hire will be responsible for.

Glock Match: Jim Finch Jim gave the report on the Glock match May 20-21.

There were no shooting safety events. Lots of thanks to club members that volunteer each year for the match. They bring their experience and knowledge of the rules to aid in the shoots. There were 224 entries this year which is down from last year. This could be due to inflation and travel and hotel costs. Glock sent their personnel for the match and are characteristically professional and on time. They were Lawson, Patti and Todd. They commented they thought the match ran smoothly. The match generated \$1068.68. There was Gate Guard coverage during the match both Saturday and Sunday. Joe Griffith was at the Match and commented it went smoothly as it always does. Looking forward Jim

Understands they already have dates locked in for next year's match. The dates for 2024 are May 17 set up and may 18-19 for the match...The dates were approved by the Board several years ago and are locked in to 2025.

Finance Report: Daryll gave the treasure report for May of 2023. Gail reported that Daryll has negotiated to pay the liability insurance monthly instead of yearly.

Daryll also explained the cost to us for the replacement of the roof shingles and gutters on all the ranges. The Insurance covered the cost with OGC spending an extra amount to place screens on the gutters.

ATF Video request: Jim Reed of the ATF made a presentation to the membership.

Due to the violence in Minneapolis and St Paul, the ATF agents were brought in. They are making a difference but want to make a public service announcement to inform the public of the guns used here. Specifically the Glock switch which changes the gun to full automatic fire. This causes a round to be fired every .2 seconds. Jim is asking to use the range to demonstrate the Glock switch. Jim is a Firearms instructor and would have another special agent Pete, who is also a Firearms instructor and a subject matter expert in firearms, actually do the firing of the Glock full auto firearm. This makes the Gun extremely difficult to control. Pete then explained he has fired the Glock full auto and understands the safety needed to do the demonstration. Pete explained the procedure he would use to do the demonstration. He would be the only person firing the Glock. The goal is to educate the public on the Glock switch. Jim also indicated this would be a closed presentation but the NY Times and other media would present at the club. Others would be interested in watching the demonstration. After answering several questions, Gail explained to Jim that a decision would be made by the board members and we would let him know. Jim and Pete left. The decision to allow the demonstration will be handled at the Board meeting.

Alcohol Drug policy: Teresa spoke to our current policy and the fact we used the term Illegal drug. Gail has updated the policy to: use of alcohol, illegal drugs or prescription drugs or marijuana is prohibited. Anyone judged to be under the influence and impaired due to this policy would be escorted off the grounds. Teresa complimented the Range officers on their handling of persons judged to be impaired on the range. Teresa also pointed out that although marijuana is legal in Minnesota under State Law it is illegal under Federal Law.

Drawing: voted to have two drawings of \$10 each. Winners were #5 Barry Thompson and #21 Ken Nelson. **Motion to adjourn** 07:55 PM.

Byron also spoke about the drain on the membership service of providing gate guards Joel asked if there could be a special badge for all the kids shooting trap to allow access to the club. Jack spoke to the idea and indicated it would be difficult to manage. Discussion followed on different ideas to solve the problem. There is more than H.S. trap that uses the range when we are not open to the public. This issue will be discussed further in other meeting.

Interim Treasure position: Gail indicated a member was interested but was not present. Gail would like him to come to a Board meeting prior to assuming the position to learn more about his qualifications.

Clay Targets: Troy said we are low and have about 6weeks supply or less. There is at least a 30-day lead time. He would like to order a truck load or possibly share a load with another club. Daryll said we have enough money to order the truck load. Troy also would like a \$500 for spare parts for the machines. He would recommend the H.S. trap teams pay more than once a season to help cover the cost of their shooting over the season.

Picnic: Byron, There is a low turnout for the picnic so far. Only 32 people so far. Want to change the \$200 for gift cards to put cash in envelops in smaller numbers for the prizes. That was approved.

Muzzleloader class: Member came to ask to teach a muzzleloader class on the range. Would also include black power cartridges. He needs to submit application to teach with his credentials and proof of insurance to Teresa.

ATF use of range: Gail made a motion to vote yes or no to the ATF request to use range for a presentation. All Board members present voted **no.**

Meeting adjourned at 9:02 PM.


