OGC May Member Meeting Minutes

OGC Member Meeting
May 10, 2023

Meeting started at 7:005 PM by President Gail Angone.

There were 23 members present.

The Pledge was said at the start the meeting.

Minutes: Duane read the minutes of the April Member and Board meetings

The Minutes were approved as read.

Finance: Daryll reported on the current finances of the club for April.

There was a question about the money allocated to the grant projects. Gail said

We have agreed to pay 50% of the cost of the grants projects but we have up to one year for pay out of the money.

4H Shooting: Jennifer Anderson: Kids do trap and 22 shooting here. She is also the coordinator for wildlife in Washington County so the Kids need to get 8 hours of Wildlife so they walk around the OGC grounds checking out the wildlife here.

Dean added there is an area that is used for FAS training that would be good for the Wildlife walk.

Security: Jack, Working with the Post Office Store for the best rate to send out the badges He has received the envelopes now. He will be sending the badges out and the cost will be half as much as regular rate. Our current security system is obsolete and cannot be repaired if broken. Lloyds security update said they will not have to rewire or replace the card readers we currently have. But will

only replace the electronics and software with cost about \$14864. The security closet will have remote access after the new software update. Should eliminate our problem with the gate closing as he will be able to access it remotely.

Stop The Blood: Joel held training for this with 60 signed up 48 persons attending and 13 no shows. He also held DNR Field day with 34 participants 8 cancellations and 3 no shows. With 25 DNR instructors assisting. Washington Co Fair is August 2 thru the 6th with all volunteers signed up.

Grant and Bylaws: Bylaws committee so far 2 people have volunteered. Grant funding so far 1 person has volunteered. She would like one person to lead the project.

Roofs and Gutters: Dean, Roofs and gutters have been done all is needed now is the inspection. The inspector will contact the insurance company and we will get the remaining money owed after that. There was a lot of dry rot. The tree clean-up is complete. Had 2 work parties only working on the tree damage. Member Tom Heckel brought his wood chipper and was a great help in the cleanup. Lots of Firewood available.

House Organize: Gail, Lee Berg volunteered to help. There is a lot of stuff in the house and garage that need to be organized or removed.

Shotgun on range: Member requested to be allowed to shoot buck shot on the range. Current only slug allowed. Discussed the different types of ammo now available. The Comp range could be used with a special mobile target stand that would allow shooting different shot sizes for patterning. Will check with others before passing.

ATF Video: Gail, ATF agent Jeff Reed made a request to do a video using the range. His emphasis is on using Glock switches. Minneapolis seems to be a hot spot for their use. Discussion followed on impact to OGC We will look into this further before action. We will ask Jeff to come out and talk to us about this.

Picnic: Byron, would like to purchase \$25 gift cards for prizes with \$200 total.

Motion made purchase 8 gift cards for \$25, seconded all voting Aye.

Drawing: voted to have two drawings of \$10 each. Winners were 17 Barry Thompson and #15 Jeremy Stikkan.

Would be nice to have an Accounting firm for advice.

EPA lead reclamation: Herb, not able to come. Hold to next meeting.

Discussed the ranges to process. Trap range is the only one possible.

Trap: Troy B, New patches for Trap for “25 straight” . Possible use for novice trap and High School. Would like to find out what is being done for completion of new

Trap building. Looking at concrete slab, electrical, readers. Some of the work he noted is already scheduled. Also make sure Trap questions are sent to him and not answered by others.

House: Hold for now. Need to obtain 2 quotes on Vinyl plank flooring for house. One for office area and hallways. Another for all bedrooms.

Set up one bedroom in house for a small conference room.

2023 Introduction to Firearms for Women

Public Welcome!!

Do you want to learn about handguns, rifles and shotguns?

This 1 evening + 1 day informational workshop, taught by certified safety instructors, is a way for Women to get their basic questions about firearms answered in a safe, friendly, casual, women-only classroom environment.

Note: Instructors are both Female and Male.

The workshop consists of one evening and one full day: evening is classroom discussion and Saturday morning is “hands on”. Then experience an afternoon of live fire range time on Saturday afternoon.

You do not need to have any previous shooting experience to take this class or own a firearm.

A wide variety of firearms will be provided at no extra cost for those who wish to try them during the range session. This course neither promotes the ownership of firearms nor will any be offered for sale during the course. This class is open to the public. You must be at least 18 years of age to take this class, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian. Other restrictions may apply.

The cost of this course is \$50.00 (includes: class materials, firearm rentals and ammo) and must be pre-paid to hold your registration. The class is limited to 30 women on a first come basis.

This class is only held once a year.

The 2023 Class has been scheduled.

Wednesday June 7th from 5:30pm to 9pm in the classroom at OGC

Saturday June 10th 9:00am-5:00pm: from 9:00am-12:00pm “hands-on” in the classroom with lunch 12p-1p (you may bring your own or leave for lunch) then 1:00 pm to 5:00pm shoot one-on-one with instructors on the range.

You must attend both Wednesday evening and Saturday’s morning class to be able to shoot on the range Saturday afternoon.

Trap Tip of the Month

Establish proper gun fit

When shooting trap or any other discipline of shotgun sports, gun fit is a key element. The criticality of the proper gun fit cannot be overstated, as gun fit can impact your ability to acquire and break the target. It can also affect how much you can comfortably practice, your endurance during an event, and the way you feel for days after the event due to soreness and bruising from recoil, or lack thereof.

Most guns meant to be sold off-the-shelf are built for an "average" height and build shooter. This means there are few shooters who buy a gun that fits them perfectly without some modification. Fitting your gun may include length alteration, comb height adjustment, or cast change. There are excellent gun fitters all over the country and it's likely that your local trap club staff can recommend one in your area.

WHAT IS THE POSTAL MATCH??

The OGC Postal Match is great fun, gives shooters a goal to achieve as well as a reason to practice and improve his / hers shooting skills. The term "Postal" refers to the manner by which targets are exchanged, the US Mail. The Postal Match works like this;

Shooters choose only the events they want to participate in. Fee per event is \$5.00 and the deadline for entries is June 15, 2023.

The events are:

- Handgun (Revolver) @ 10 Yards, open sights, timed fire.
- Handgun (Autoloader) @ 10 Yards, open sights, timed fire.
- Handgun (Rimfire) @ 10 Yards, open sights, timed fire.
- Handgun Unlimited 100 Yards, any caliber, any sight.
- Lever Action @ 100 Yards, scope, timed fire.
- Lever Action @ 100 Yards, iron sights, timed fire.
- Rimfire Rifle @ 100 Yards, scope, timed fire.
- Rimfire Rifle @ 50 Yards, open/iron sights, timed fire.
- Hunting Rifle (.270 Min Cal) @ 100 Yards, scope, timed fire.
- Hunting Rifle (.270 Min Cal) @ 100 Yards, iron sights, timed fire.
- Varmint Rifle @ 200 Meters, scope, timed fire.
- Varmint Rifle @ 200 Meters iron sights, timed Fire
- Black Powder Cartridge Rifle @ 200 yards. Scope, timed fire.
