#### Update from the President – May 2023

**OGC Finances** – the President, Vice President and Treasurer will be consulting with a financial service organization to verify that we are complying with standard financial reporting procedures . We will also inquire if an external financial audit should be considered. In 2009, a Minnesota tax bill was signed into law that included an important provision for nonprofit organizations to increase the threshold at which organizations are required to obtain an audited financial statement. The provision raises the threshold from \$350,000, where it has been for the last twelve years, to \$750,000. This alleviates the burden that a small business would incur as external audits can cost between \$10,000 and \$20,000.

Bylaw Review - a meeting was held, after the BOD meeting was adjourned, last month to refresh our memories on the proposed revisions that did not get approved at last year's annual meeting. We discussed creating a bylaw review and revision committee which would include several members as well as a few board members. We also need to review our Member Handbook to ensure that any changes to the bylaws get incorporated where applicable in the handbook. Grant Committee — as reported in earlier months, we submitted our application for grant money from Midway USA Foundation and hoping to hear our projects were approved. We have discussed setting up a committee to identify organizations that offer Grant monies toward improvements to our club. This committee would be required to prepare the documentation along with the application and follow all the requirements set by the Grant foundation(s). - Damaged trees and brush from the heavy snow this winter are being cleaned up around the club. Dean Cody is the lead on this project.

A huge thank you to Joel Charchenko and Teresa Reiter for scheduling the Stop the Bleed Clinic last month. It was a great success, and we intend to have more clinics at the club. I would like to add a thank you to our board members and volunteer members who put in the hours and get the work done. Each board member has their own work to do in their area, but we all volunteer to help each other on projects because it's important to the vitality of our club. Our members who volunteer their time to improve and maintain our club are equally important.

#### OGC Member Meeting April 12, 2023

**Finance: Daryll** reported on the current finances of the club for March.

**Grant:** Herb, Big Thanks to Hudson Raiders coaches for their help. There will be 2 requests for Grants. Total requests will be for \$59,125. First grant request is for grading trap field for drainage, walkway and stairs on trap will be removed from the left side of #1 trap and placed on the right side of trap, supplies for new NRL22 shoot of binoculars and tripods, grading for the 100 and 200yd ranges. and Grant two for to enhance Firearm safety equipment of ground and elevated blinds. The package for grants was submitted. The requirement is to complete projects in one year. Any money not used will be returned. We will hear in a couple of months of approval.

**Roof Replacement**: Dean, Will have to wait until road restrictions are removed before project can start. They will try to work around events on the range.

**Stop the Bleed**: Joel, Coming to the club on April 13. Have about 55 people signed up. There will be presentations and hands-on during the class.

**Badges**: Jack, all badges are printed. Working with Post Office for discount on mailings. Have had to open a new postal account for this. Lloyds came out to give estimates on changes that need to be made. Our equipment is old and needs to be replaced as it cannot be serviced.

**Service Hours**, Byron, 743 members have signed up and 67 new members have signed up. Replaced calendar on website

**NRL22 shoot**: Jeannie, held 2 matches so far in March and April. Had 27 shooters in March with 9 Oakdale members. There were 29 shooters in April with 9 new shooters. Most people coming are not Oakdale Members. Tom Baker and Tom Schaeffer paid for the targets. Jeannie has their own targets and is using them for the matches. There will be some expenses later to renew membership in NRL22 and equipment needs.

# Public Welcome!! At: Oakdale Gun Club 10386 – 10<sup>th</sup> St. North, Lake Elmo, MN

Do you want to learn about handguns, rifles and shotguns?

This 1 evening + 1 day informational workshop, taught by certified safety instructors, is a way for Women to get their basic questions about firearms answered in a safe, friendly, casual, women-only classroom environment.

Note: Instructors are both Female and Male.

The workshop consists of one evening and one full day: evening is classroom discussion and Saturday morning is "hands on". Then experience an afternoon of live fire range time on Saturday afternoon.

You do not need to have any previous shooting experience to take this class or own a firearm.

A wide variety of firearms will be provided at no extra cost for those who wish to try them during the range session. This course neither promotes the ownership of firearms nor will any be offered for sale during the course. This class is open to the public. You must be at least 18 years of age to take this class, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian. Other restrictions may apply.

The cost of this course is \$50.00 (includes: class materials, firearm rentals and ammo) and must be prepaid to hold your registration. The class is limited to 30 women on a first come basis.

This class is only held once a year.

The 2023 Class has been scheduled.

Wednesday June 7th from 5:30pm to 9pm in the classroom at OGC

Saturday June 10<sup>th</sup> 9:00am-5:00pm: from 9:00am-12:00pm "hands-on" in the classroom with lunch 12p-1p (you may bring your own or leave for lunch) then 1:00 pm to 5:00pm shoot one-on-one with instructors on the range.

You must attend both Wednesday evening and Saturday's morning class to be able to shoot on the range Saturday afternoon.

#### **Postal Match**

#### WHAT IS THE POSTAL MATCH??

The OGC Postal Match is great fun, gives shooters a goal to achieve as well as a reason to practice and improve his / hers shooting skills. The term "Postal" refers to the manner by which targets are exchanged, the US Mail. The Postal Match works like this;

Shooters choose only the events they want to participate in. Fee per event is \$5.00 and the dead-line for entries is June 15, 2023.

Rimfire Rifle @ 50 Yards, open/iron sights, timed fire.

Hunting Rifle (.270 Min Cal) @ 100 Yards, scope, timed fire.

Hunting Rifle (.270 Min Cal) @ 100 Yards, iron sights, timed fire.

Varmint Rifle @ 200 Meters, scope, timed fire.

Varmint Rifle @ 200 Meters iron sights, timed Fire

Black Powder Cartridge Rifle @ 200 yards. Scope, timed fire.


